#1 DRAW YOUR CURRENT FLOOR PLAN

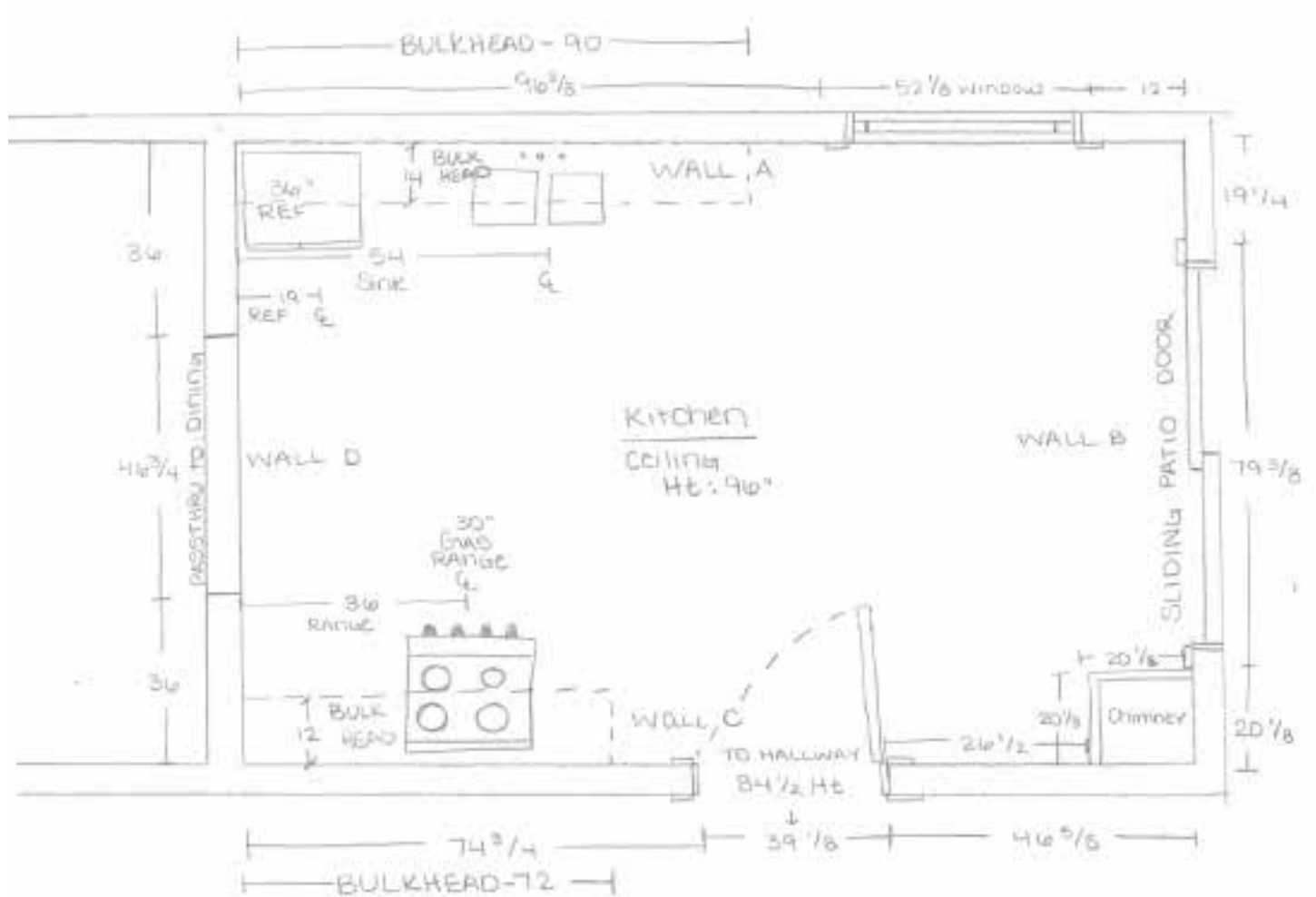
The first step is to draw your current floor plan.

The floor plan shows your space from a "bird's eye view."

Try to include as many measurements as possible. Don't worry if you can't list them all; you can give more details on these measurements in step #2 when you draw the individual walls of your space.

Sketch your floor plan using the graph paper on the following page.

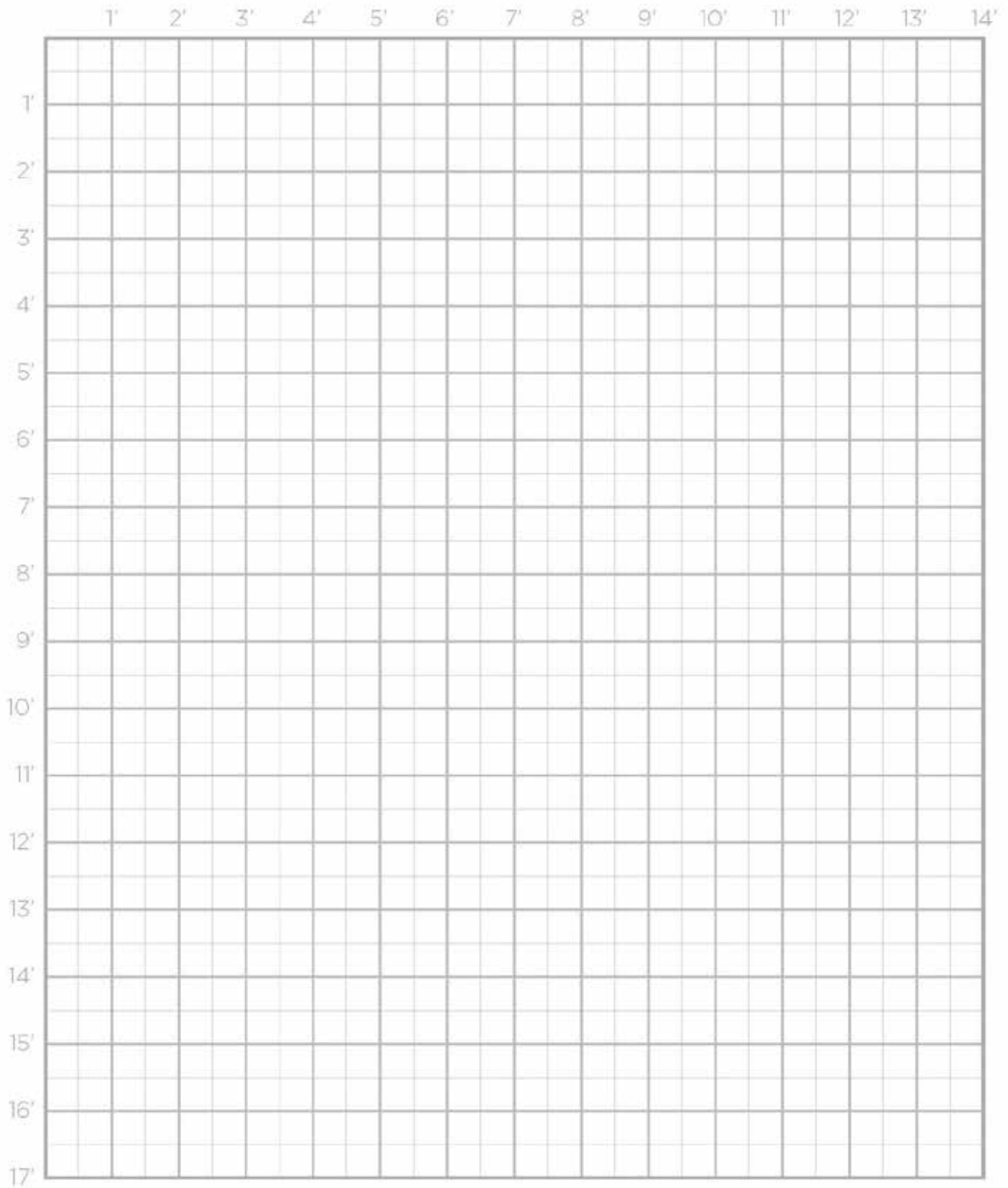
Example Floor Plan:

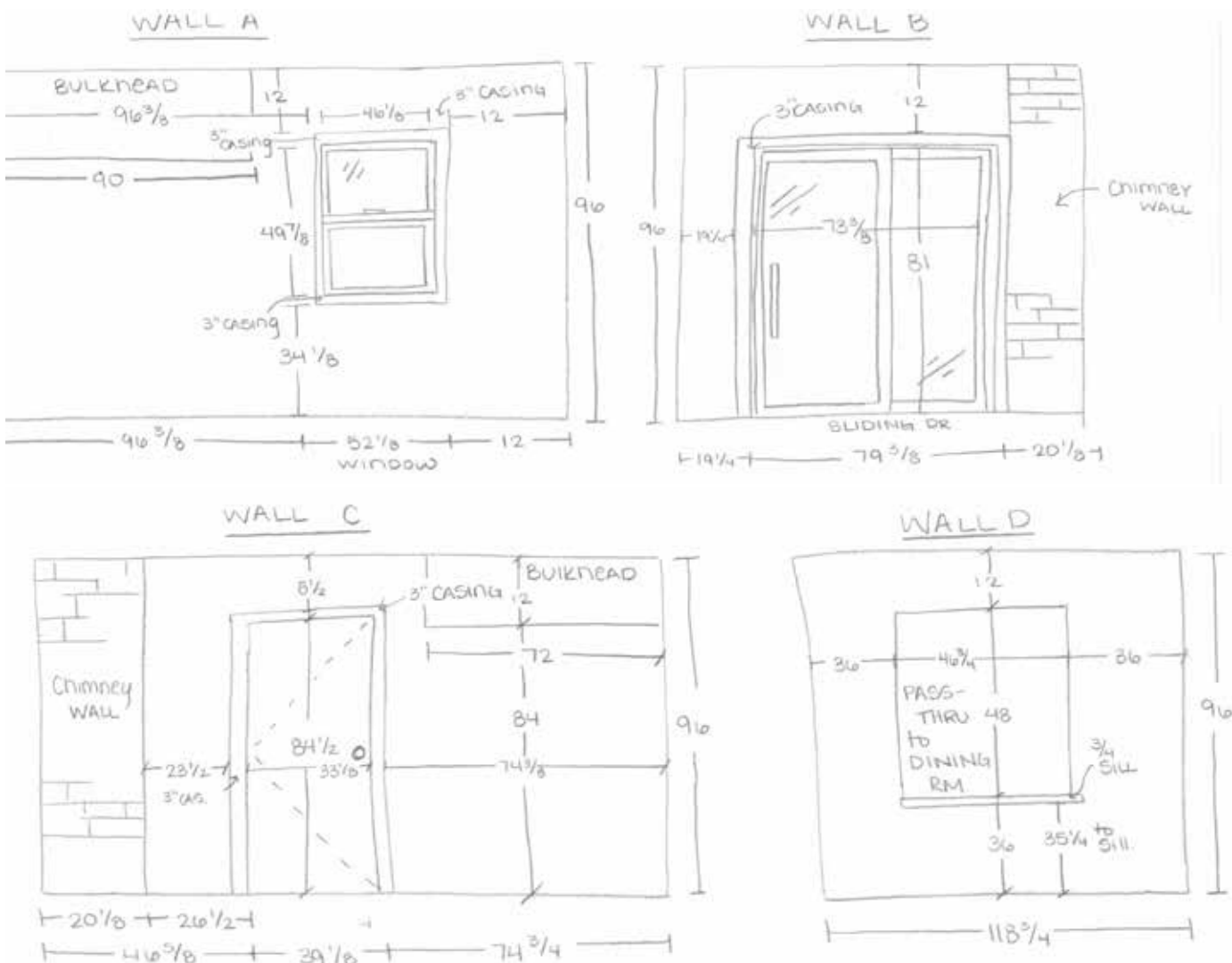

#4 SUBMIT CURRENT KITCHEN PHOTOS

In order to properly plan for your new cabinets, we prefer to have real-life photos of your current kitchen or bath.

Please use the Following Guidelines When Taking Pictures:

1. Have the room well lit
2. Take pictures of the complete wall area
3. Match the photo name with the wall number and dimensions (see page 4 for examples)
4. Show both wall and base cabinets
5. Take pictures of any unique architectural elements, such as soffits, bulkheads, or bump outs
6. Show all doors, windows, and walkways
